The greens renovation on the Executive Golf Course is coming along nicely. The greens were stripped of the old, tired turf and planted (sprigged) with TifEagle ultradwarf Bermudagrass. Weather permitting, we plan on a November 8th opening. This will be only for residents and members as well as KPMGA and KPWGA. The following week will be open to outside play and all other groups. The back nine greens were delayed due to unavailability of grass from the turf farm in Georgia and a minor setback from the Tornado. The Par 3 Golf Course has remained open all summer and we've already seen many of our groups coming over to play. Online booking is available on our website. Kingspointgolfdelray.com. Residents and members now have 5 days in advance to book tee times. Please help golf maintenance by filling divots and repairing ball marks on greens. We are experiencing a lot of people wandering on the golf course after hours either hitting balls or just walking down the paths. This is not allowed, and those folks will be dealt with by security and or PBSO. If you see this happening, please call one of these offices.

Things to Remember...

Tee Time Phone - Operates seven days a week from 7 AM to 10 am. Take advantage of this service for a more preferred tee time by calling 561-638-2719. You will find that our customer service is second to none. Golf Etiquette - Please be considerate of fellow golfers by repairing divots, raking bunkers etc. Play ready golf to help maintain a reasonable pace of play. Do not hit into other golfers or maintenance staff.

Golf Carts - Please return golf carts after play is complete. This helps our staff recycle them for other golfers.

Fishing for Golf Balls - Please be mindful that a two-minute time limit applies to looking for your golf ball hit into the water. Fishing for balls other than the ball you are playing is prohibited. Alligators are always present.

Stay Hydrated - Remember to drink plenty of fluids while you are on the course. Water and PowerAde are available in vending machines and at the Snack Bar.

PRIVILEGE CARDS are currently on sale at the Par 3 pro-shop. These cards offer big discounts. Cards are good through May 1st 2023. The cards will be valid for 11 rounds and includes carts. Call 561-499-0140 for additional information. **There is still plenty of time to use these**
