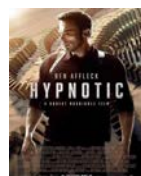

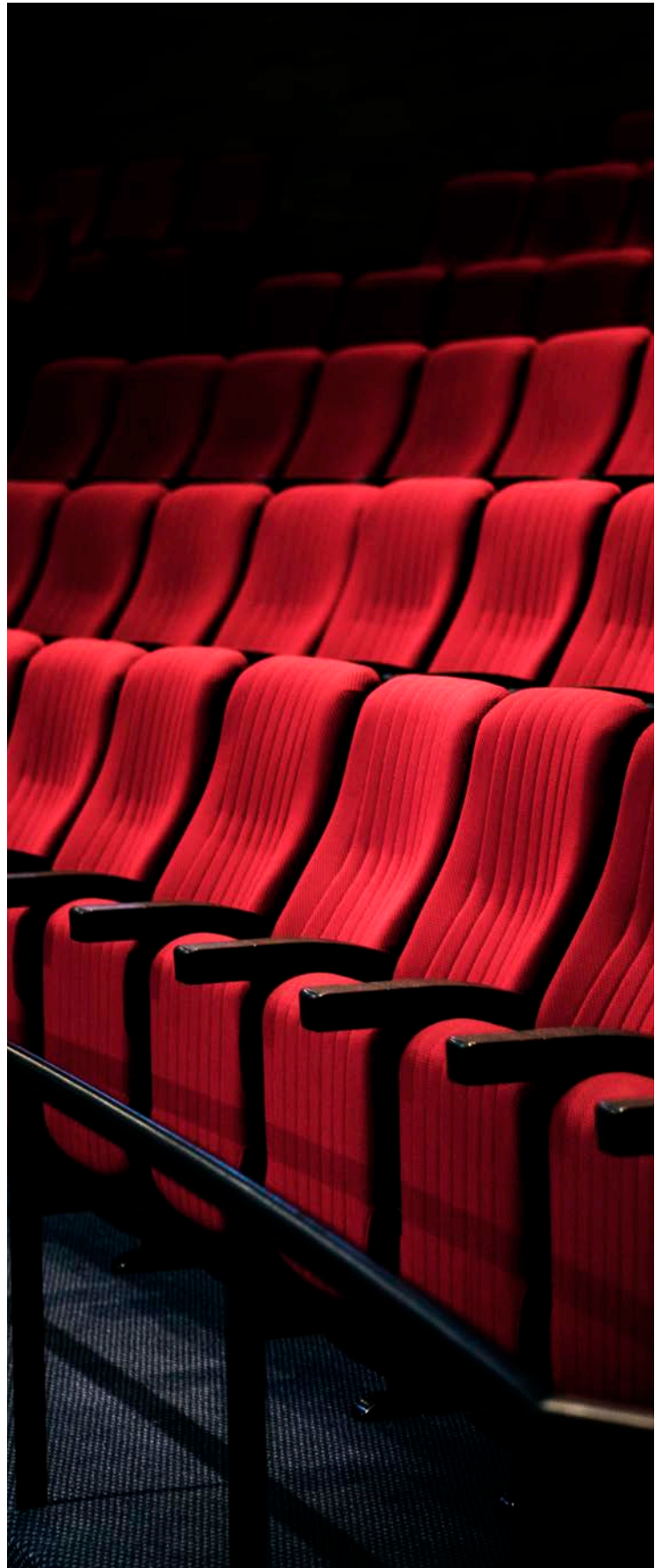

Alliance of Delray News

Updating Infrastructure and Amenities in Our County Park System

Jennifer Cirillo, Director of Palm Beach Parks and Recreation, recently spoke at an Alliance of Delray meeting which was held at the Morikami Museum and Gardens, a crown jewel of Palm Beach County. She began by explaining the vastness of the 8,668 acre park system comprised of 110 parks (11 of these locations are undeveloped future park sites).

Accomplishments of the Department this year include an overall contribution to economic impact through Sports Tourism of \$10,200,000. The Aquatics Division successfully taught swim lessons to 979 participants in partnership with the Drowning Prevention Coalition and Red Cross. Additionally, 46 students received their free lifeguard certification through an innovative pilot program funded by the Children Services Council of Palm Beach County.

Further, the parks system adapted to increased demand for facilities through innovation and resourcefulness as evidenced by the thirty eight pickleball courts which were constructed in the last three years by mostly repurposing older rinks and courts. Partnerships have been created and grants have been secured for other facilities.

Challenges facing the Parks and Recreation Department include aging facilities and amenities, along with increased public demand, climate changes and emerging recreation and technology trends. Significant capital improvements and infrastructure funding strategies are being implemented.

Director Cirillo encouraged the audience to view the Parks and Recreation informational video at <https://youtu.be/wiTJHxVKDJU> and to consider volunteering by visiting <https://discover.pbcgov.org/parks/General/Volunteer.aspx>.

The Palm Beach County Parks & Recreation Department is a two-time National Gold Medal winner and eight-time finalist for Excellence in Parks and Recreation.

Poolside BBQs will be held every other Friday between the Flanders and the Main Clubhouse Pools. Please check the KP website for exact dates and location.

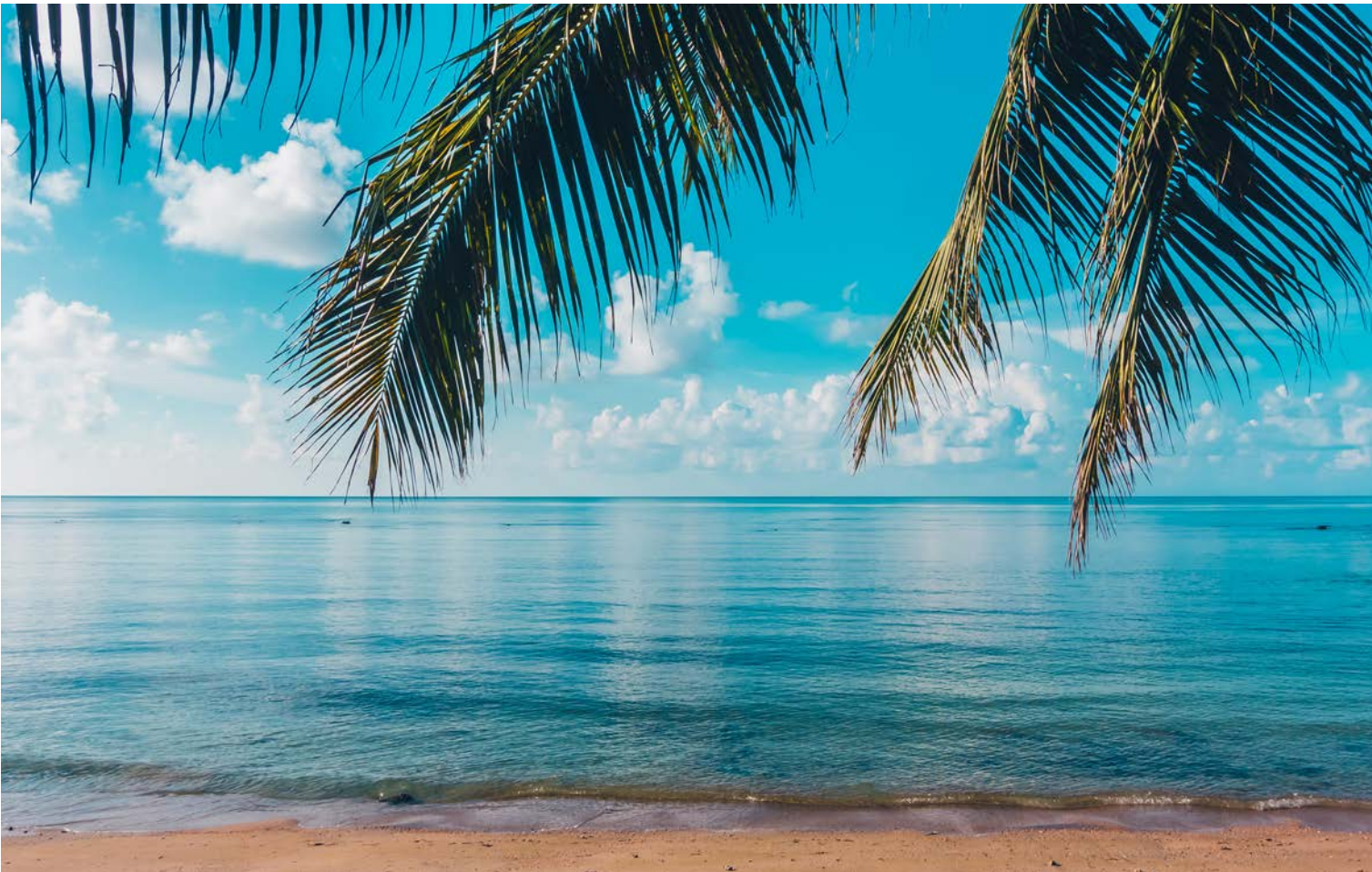
