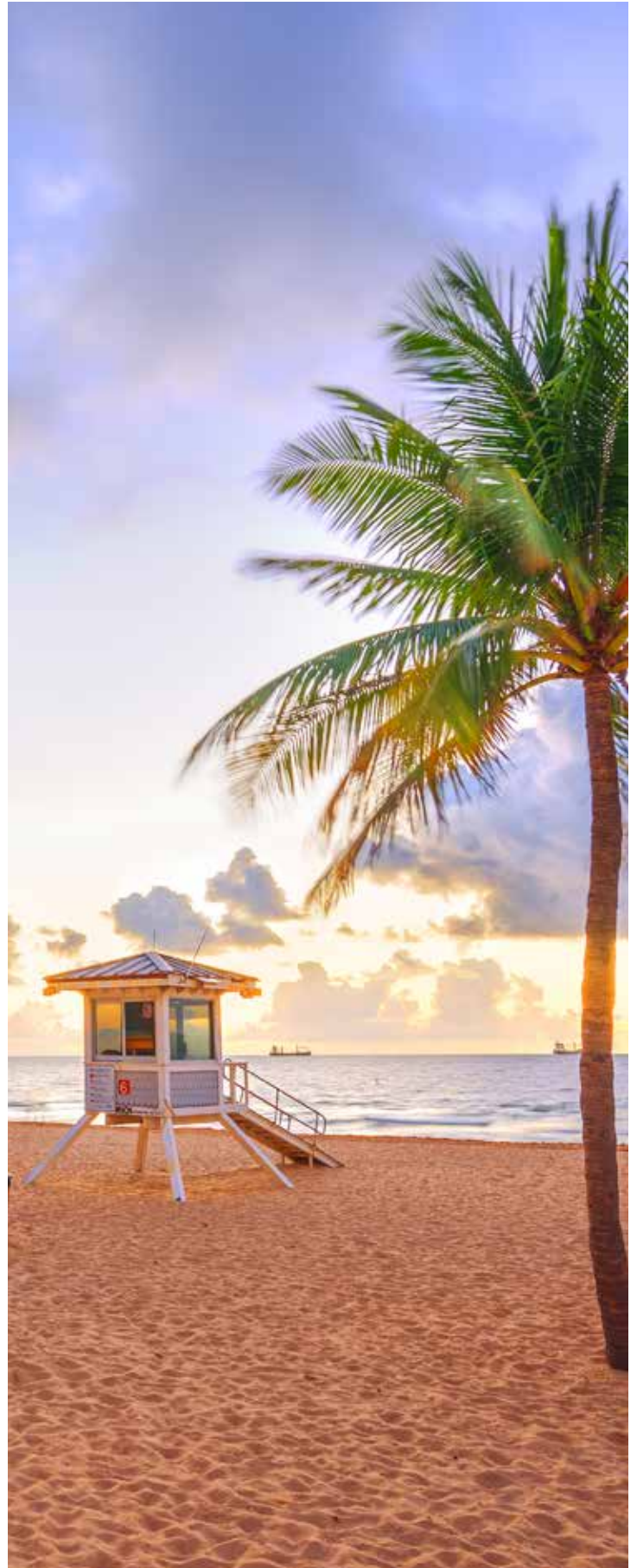
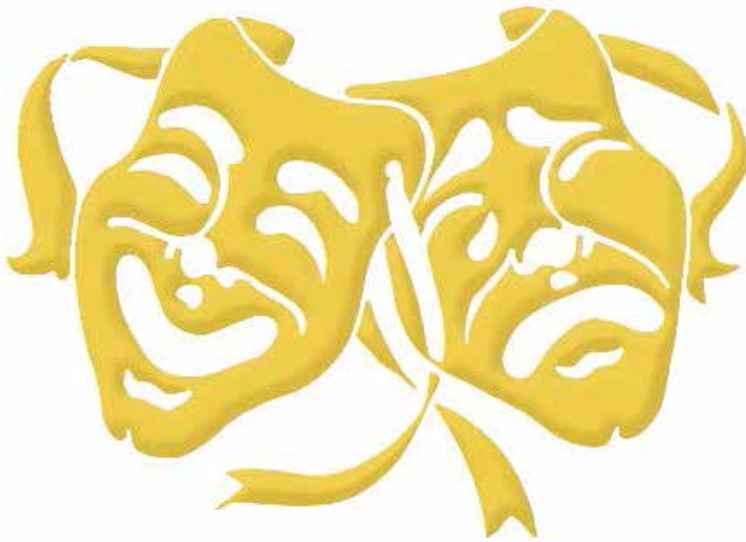

## More Ambulance Services Available on the Horizon

The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted Ordinance Number 2024-022 on October 22, 2024 which would allow the BCC to issue additional Secondary Provider Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) prior to the end of the regular six (6) year term that is outlined in the Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Ordinance. The Alliance supports this initiative of the BCC.

Examples of current Secondary Provider COPCN's include AMR and MEDICS and many residents have used these services for transport from one medical facility to another.

Palm Beach County (PBC) Code, Chapter 13, Article II, EMS Ordinance, states that any agency desiring to provide secondary Advanced Life Support (ALS) transport services and ALS/Basic Life Support (BLS) Inter-facility transport services must submit an application to the County and meet the requirements for issuance of a COPCN.

On February 4, 2025, the BCC will be hearing from several applicants seeking to provide ambulance services in Palm Beach County. The Alliance will be present at this meeting to emphasize the need for choosing additional efficient and competent private ambulance providers. The residents of PBC require prompt response from a service that has the most advanced medical equipment to serve patients and technology that includes advanced Global Positioning System (GPS) and Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) systems to optimize arrival times and deliver fast and reliable emergency medical services.

In previous correspondence to the BCC the Alliance suggested that future contracts should have providers include the number of units available at all times which is one factor that would add to efficient delivery of services.

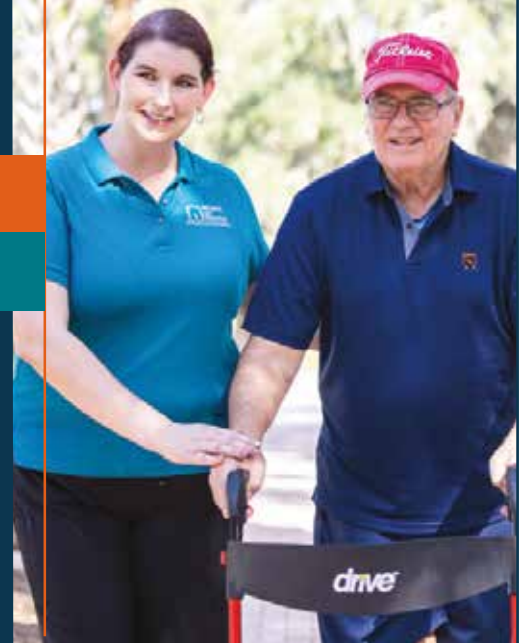
