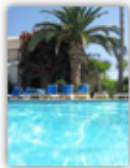

Public Comment Requested with PBCmoves.com

In addition to Palm Beach County's (PBC) official website which can be accessed at pbcgov.com and pbcgov.org, the County has created a new website which will lead the way to further development of the Transportation Master Plan. PBCmoves.com provides information on the Countywide Transportation Master Plan (CTMP). The goal of the CTMP is to establish a planning framework that provides for a countywide vision for transportation and mobility that safely connects people to places and provides for a multijurisdictional process. The plan will be the first key step toward a Countywide transportation and mobility plan for PBC and municipalities within the County to separately adopt and/or update their own specific plan of improvements, using the recommended Countywide plan as a foundation.

The PBC Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved a contract with a consulting firm, WSP USA Inc., on June 18, 2025 for the development of the CTMP. WSP is a professional services firm with national and international experience in transportation.

The document will become the primary baseline for transportation and mobility planning in PBC to achieve the following: A. Establish best practices for regional mobility; B. Promote and include design principles for safe streets; C. Address the transportation planning of regionally significant corridors that traverse various jurisdictions (i.e. County roadways and collector roadways, regional transit systems); D. Integrate for land use and transportation; E. Establish common Goals, Objectives and Policies within PBC; F. Define multi-jurisdictional processes.

The study will also provide information for the County to formulate "Mobility Impact Fees" for completion of the goals. Mobility Impact Fees would help to pay for components of the transportation system other than expansion of roadways. These components include additional bus shelters and sidewalks.

The framework of the CTMP project indicates that it will take 12 months to complete. During the first four months, public input is encouraged. At PBCmoves.com residents can contact the project coordinators and provide comments or ask questions.

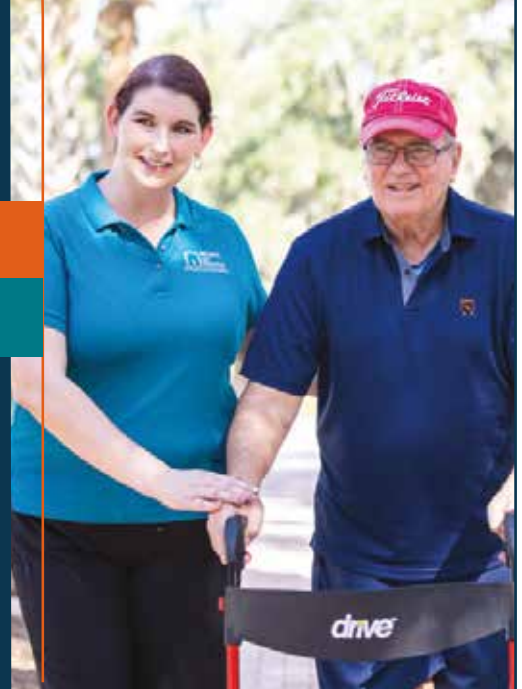

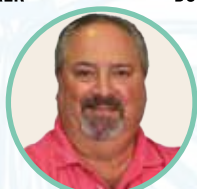

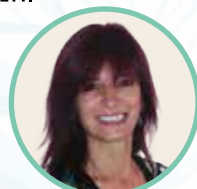
