

- Absolutely no food, drinks or candy is allowed in the theatre.





FUN HISTORICAL FACTS FROM 1968

In 1968, Lyndon B. Johnson was the president of the United States.

The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.4%, and the nation's inflation rate was 4.19%.

The median household income was \$7,743, and the average new home cost \$26,600.

In 1968, a gallon of milk cost \$1.07, eggs were 53 cents a dozen, and hamburger buns were 25 cents for an eight-ounce package.

Movie tickets were \$1.50 apiece.

In 1968, McDonald's launched the legendary Big Mac.

Funny Girl was the highest-grossing film, and Bonanza (NBC) was a top-rated TV show.

The ever-popular news magazine, 60 Minutes, debuted on CBS.



Some of the top songs of 1968 included classics like "Hey Jude" by The Beatles, "I Heard It Through the Grapevine" by Marvin Gaye, and "Jumpin' Jack Flash" by The Rolling Stones.

On April 11, President Johnson signed the 1968 Civil Rights Act into law.

Consumer products launched during the year included bean bag chairs, Hunt's Snack Pack, Pringles, Steak-umms (thinly sliced steaks), Tic Tacs, and Ziploc bags.

Famous birthdays were Barry Sanders, Celine Dion, Gary Coleman, Gillian Anderson, Kenny Chesney, Lisa Marie Presley, and Rachael Ray.

The Boston Celtics were the NBA champs, the Detroit Tigers won the World Series, and the Montreal Canadiens clinched the Stanley Cup. In addition, Vince Lombardi stepped down as the head coach of the Green Bay Packers.

ICA Hosts February & March Safety Programs for All Kings Point Residents


Be Informed. Be Prepared. Be Safe.

Free Standing Emergency Department Proposed for Delray Beach

On December 15, 2025 the City of Delray Beach Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Board heard an application brought by JFK Hospital for a Free Standing Emergency Department (FSED). The hospital itself is located in the City of Atlantis/Lake Worth. The application proposes the construction of an FSED on Atlantic Avenue in Delray Beach which would be located about 15 miles from the main hospital. Surrounding residents are concerned not only because of the proposed 24/7 hours/late night operation, but also for the extra burden to patients who might seek care at the FSED.

FSED's are different from "doc in a box" walk-in urgent care clinics which are often located in malls and provide quick care for minor illnesses. FSED's are hospital-affiliated emergency rooms where ambulances frequently bring victims of falls and other ailments.

Residents should be aware of issues surrounding FSED's which are associated with a hospital outside of the local area.

If the FSED decides a patient needs to be admitted to the hospital, the patient usually would be transferred by ambulance to the main hospital campus which would add extra time for transport. With time-sensitive issues such as stroke or trauma, this could be risky. If the patient requests to be transported to his or her local hospital, an additional transport fee might be charged. Further, the FSED may be in the patient's insurance network but the hospital may be out of network leading to unexpected medical charges.

Sometimes the FSED looks like a full hospital but it may not be since most FSED's do not have operating rooms, Intensive Care Units, or admissions.

If the patient is admitted to the FSED's parent hospital located in another city, continuity of care could be compromised. The patient's own primary care physician and specialists may not be associated with the hospital and medical records not as easily accessible. Family may need to travel farther to visit so personal items and support can be more difficult to manage.

The potential problems associated with seeking emergency care in an FSED associated with an out-of-area hospital are not related to the quality of the attending physicians or staff or hospital's accreditation.

The Delray Beach P&Z Board continued the public hearing to February 23, 2026. Local residents will be able to present their concerns and a decision should be made on whether to approve a 24/7/late night variance for the FSED associated with JFK Hospital.


